

Union Sports Arena 2008 High School Spring Leagues

“Varsity A” Division

This division is designed for experienced team entrants looking to play in a highly competitive checking division. Only experienced teams searching for the most challenging program should consider this division.

“Varsity B” Division

This division is perfect for established High School teams to introduce incoming freshman and JV players to competitive High School hockey. It is also an excellent forum to establish new or growing teams.

- The season will consist of 10 games from April 13 to Sun. June 15, 2008.
- Most games will be played Saturday and/or Sunday afternoons/ evenings with overflow games on Thursday or Friday nights.
- Each team will have 4, 1-hour practices beginning the week of March 31.
- 2 practices will be shared-ice, 2 will be full ice. All practices will be held on weekday evenings.
- Playoffs will run from Thursday, June 19 through Sunday, June 22.
- Playoff format will be determined based upon the number of teams registering.

Please Note:

- All team applications must be submitted, with required payment (see below), by March 1, 2008.
- No games will be played Easter Sunday or Memorial Day Weekend.
- Full equipment is required for all Union Sports Arena Hockey programs.
- The Varsity A and Varsity B programs are for current or entering High School students - including Seniors - born 1994 or earlier.
- All players must be registered with USA Hockey (Managers: provide copies of current USA Hockey cards or \$40 registration fee per non-registered player.)

Teams: Cost \$4200

- Maximum of 20 players (including goalies) on roster (USA Hockey rules).
- Team application accepted with a \$2500.00 deposit, due March 1, 2008. Balance due by April 7, 2008.
- Team entrants must provide rosters and uniforms.
- Managers / Team Organizers: Don't forget to include your coach and jerseys (about \$30/player) when calculating your player fee.

Individual Players: Cost \$325

- Individuals will be placed onto existing teams, or organized into one or more “house” teams.
- Union Sports Arena will provide jerseys and coaches for individuals organized into “house” teams.
- Application due by **March 15, 2008**. Full fee must be paid with application.

League Rules:

- USA Hockey rules apply, except where superceded by house rules.
- Fighting penalties, or any other gross misconduct penalty, may result in expulsion from the league for any remaining games in the season.
- For players to participate in playoffs, they must have played in at least 5 of the initial 10 games.
- All games have 15-minute periods.
- Running time for a 6 goal (or greater) differential in the third period.
